DETERMINATIONS

The following determination is to be taken to have been made by the local government under clause 2.1 of the *Town of Cambridge Local Government and Public Property Local Law 2017*, at the Council meeting held on 21 December 2021.

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

1.1 Definitions:

In this determination unless the context otherwise requires –

‘local law’ means the *Town of Cambridge Local Government and Public Property Local Law 2017*;

‘local government property’ means anything which belongs to, is owned by or is under the care, control or management of the local government, and includes any flora and fauna thereon;

‘reserve’ means any land —

- (a) which belongs to the local government that is zoned as and, used for, recreational purposes;
- (b) of which the local government is the management body under the *Land Administration Act 1997*; or
- (c) which is an 'otherwise unvested facility' within the meaning of section 3.53 of the Act;

‘vehicle’ includes —

- (a) every conveyance and every object capable of being propelled or drawn on wheels, tracks or otherwise; and
- (b) an animal being ridden or driven, but excludes —
 - (i) a wheel-chair or any device designed for use by physically impaired persons;
 - (ii) a pram, a stroller or similar device;
 - (iii) a boat; and
 - (iv) a shopping trolley;

1.2 Interpretation:

Unless the context otherwise requires, where a term is used but not defined in a determination and that term is defined in the local law then the term shall have the meaning given to it in the local law.

PART 2 – DETERMINATIONS

Vehicles allowed on local government property

2. A person shall not without the consent of the Council —
- (a) bring, ride or drive a vehicle onto local government property, or reserve, or a portion thereof or permit any person to bring, ride or drive a vehicle onto local government property, or reserve, or a portion, except on or over such parts of the local government property as is set aside as an area for such use.”

PART 3 - TRIAL PERIOD

This Determination is effective from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2022.
