

## COUNCIL POLICY NO: 090

<b>Responsible Directorate</b>	Infrastructure and Works

### OBJECTIVE:

To identify a standard street name and rights of way signs for the Town of Cambridge that:-

- Promotes the streets and municipality of the Town of Cambridge;
- Provides an easily noticeable and readable sign for the motoring public; and/or
- Is economic to supply, erect and maintain.

### SCOPE:

This policy applies to all Directorates of the Town of Cambridge (“the Town”).

### POLICY STATEMENT:

- That the Town maintains a system of street name and rights of way signs at each intersection that conforms to Australian Standard 1742.5 – Manual of uniform traffic control devices. Street name and community facility name signs; and
- That Western Power has given approval for the Town to fix street name and rights of way signs to their poles where suitable. Alternatively, specific purpose poles be erected to carry the street and rights of way name signs.
- The signs shall be made from extruded aluminium section with a scalloped end.
- The size and colour of the sign shall be 200mm plate with reflectorized white background and dark green text 140mm high.
- That the Town logo shall be included on all street name signs with numbering from the nearest house (ie 14- UP, 15-DN)

### DEFINITIONS:

Definitions are taken as those detailed in the *Local Government Act 1995* and associated legislation.
