As a registered dog owner you are required to comply with all requirements of the Dog Act 1976 at all times. Penalties apply for non compliance.

This registration is valid unless cancelled pursuant to Section 16 of the Dog Act.

All dog licences expire on **31 OCTOBER**.

All dogs aged three months and over must be registered. **Micro chipping your dog is not a form of registration.**

All new dogs including pups and other dogs being registered for the first time, and, dogs where ownership is changing will need to be microchipped. Proof of Microchip certificate must be provided.

All dangerous dogs must be microchipped by 30 November 2013. Proof of Microchip Certificate must be provided.

All other dogs must be microchipped by 1 November 2015.

At all times, dogs must wear a current registration tag, together with an identification disc, with the name and residential address of the owner legibly endorsed or inscribed on or attached to the collar.

When exercising your dog within the metropolitan area (other than in approved dog exercise areas) your dog must be on a leash. The person holding the leash must be able to control the dog in all situations.

This means:

- You can easily hold the dog on the leash, without the dog pulling away from you.
- You can prevent the dog from rushing up to other dogs or people.
- The dog will follow basic obedience commands such as "sit", "stay" and "heel".

Children must not be allowed to walk a dog on their own unless they have full control.

The only partial refund of registration fees will occur when an unsterilized dog is subsequently sterilised.

In approved dog exercise areas the dog may only be allowed off the leash when the person responsible for the dog is close by and able to control the dog.

Council must be notified immediately if any particulars contained in this application change.
