I hereby declare that:

- a. the food business is registered and I am the licensed proprietor of the food business, as required by S110 of the Food Act 2008,
- b. the business holds a current public indemnity insurance policy for not less than \$10 million and a certificate of currency of that policy is attached,
- c. the consumption of alcohol is / is not permitted in the outdoor eating facility.

## ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

In support of this application, the following are attached:

- a. A plan to scale and specification of the proposed eating area showing:
  - i) the position of tables, chairs and structures proposed to be provided in the proposed outdoor eating facility; and
  - ii) the location and dimensions of the proposed outdoor eating facility.
- b. A plan to scale and specification of the proposed outdoor eating facility and the area incorporated within 30 metres beyond the boundaries of the proposed eating area showing the location of all carriageways, footpaths, public facilities, public places, streets and street alignments.
- c. Colour photographs or brochures of the tables, chairs and other structures intended to be used in the proposed outdoor eating facility.

## NOTE TO ALL APPLICANTS

Adequate public indemnity insurance arrangements to the satisfaction of the Town are required. Any Permit issued under the Trading in Public Places Local Law is conditional upon the permit holder having a current and acceptable public indemnity insurance policy with an Underwriter acceptable to the Council. A person applying for a permit to set up and conduct an outdoor eating facility must take out a public indemnity policy for not less than \$10 million. A Certificate of Currency is to be provided on application.

Where alcohol is sold, only the holder of a liquor licence may sell liquor. Under the Liquor Control Act 1988, the holder of a liquor licence, with the consent of the Council, may be issued with an extended trading permit which can allow the sale and supply of liquor on a road or footpath.
