

CCTV SUBSIDY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The CCTV system must be installed on a property within the Town of Cambridge prior to lodging the CCTV Subsidy Partnership Program application form.
2. The subsidy is only available to systems that have been installed within **three** months prior to your application being submitted. No retrospective rebates are available.
3. The CCTV Subsidy Partnership Program is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Subsidies will only be issued where approved, and until budgeted funding for the financial year is exhausted. The Town reserves its right to not issue any further subsidies for the remainder of the financial year.
4. The CCTV system must be purchased and installed by a business registered with a Security Agents Licence Number. Any systems installed without this will not be eligible for the subsidy.
Please note: The Town does not have preferred suppliers for the installation of CCTV cameras.
5. If the applicant is not the owner of the property, written approval from the owner or owner's representative must be obtained and included with the application.
6. The applicant must register their CCTV system with the WA Police CCTV register website database: <https://cam-mapwa.police.wa.gov.au/> prior to a subsidy being granted.
7. All requested documentation needs to be provided to the satisfaction of the Town before the subsidy is issued.
8. The CCTV system must have one camera angle that faces a public space (i.e. roads, footpaths, sporting reserves, parks, beaches, etc) and to the Towns satisfaction.
9. Rear properties (unless on a right of way) or properties with limited field of views of public space may not be eligible for funding.
10. The applicant must maintain the CCTV system in good working order.
11. The Town will subsidise up to \$500 towards the total cost of the approved CCTV system.
12. Subsidies will not be approved to applicants that have a current outstanding debt with the Town.
13. The Town has the right to refuse issuing a subsidy at any time if the CCTV Subsidy Partnership Program Terms and Conditions have not been met.
14. The Town will not be liable for any cost incurred by the applicant.
15. The Town has the right to amend the CCTV Subsidy Partnership Program Terms and Conditions at any time.
16. Subsidy applications will be limited to one per household.
