### **ROAD RESURFACING PROGRAM 2025/2026 Highbury Street (Bournville Street to Seymour Avenue)**

As part of the 2025/2026 Capital Works Program, the Town will be undertaking asphalt resurfacing on Highbury Street (Bournville Street to Seymour Avenue)

#### **Timeframe**

Construction works are scheduled for **16 March 2026** and **14 to 15 April 2026**. In addition to these works, minor civil works will be undertaken between these dates; however, the exact timing of these activities is yet to be confirmed. Works will generally be carried out between **7:00am and 5:00pm**, although to complete the works it may be necessary to carry out some activities outside of these hours

#### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

##### **Scope of Works**

The resurfacing will involve removing the existing asphalt surface, regulating the underlying surface with layer of asphalt, and then applying a new asphalt wearing course. To assist with timely completion and reduce the impact of dust, please do not park vehicles on the road or verge during the works. Driving on freshly laid asphalt can damage the surface and increase the risk of bitumen adhering to tyres and transferring onto driveways.

##### **Traffic management**

Temporary road closures and detours will be in place to facilitate the works. For your safety, please follow all signage and directions. Access to properties may be affected during the resurfacing. If you need to enter or exit your property while works are in progress, please speak with the traffic controllers on site, who will provide assistance. While every effort will be made to minimise disruption, some inconvenience is unavoidable. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation during these works.
